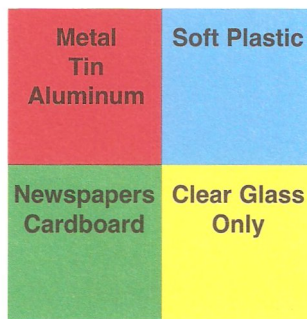

PLEASE NOTE:

Household garbage and recyclables should be placed at the curb the evening prior to the scheduled day of collection.

Week One

METAL CANS

Tin and Aluminum
Rinse, clean, remove paper labels, remove ends, and flatten.

Week Two

SOFT PLASTIC: #1 – #5

Soft plastic jugs such as milk, juice, etc.
Rinse clean, remove any hard plastic tops, rings, and flatten.

Note: Hard plastic, and empty motor oil bottles are NOT recyclable, but may be placed with the regular household garbage for collection.

Week Three

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES & CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Newspapers and magazines must be placed in manageable bundles and tied together.
(Optional to be placed in tied plastic bag.)

Corrugated cardboard must be flattened and tied together, no larger than 3' x 3'.

Note: No hardboard or pizza boxes, please place in regular trash.

Week Four

GLASS

Clear glass jars and bottles ONLY. Rinse clean, remove tops and caps.

Note: Light bulbs, windows, mirrors, crystal, ceramics, and drinking glasses are NOT recyclable, but may be placed in regular garbage for collection.

2012 HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

The Village of Lakewood's garbage and recycling contractor will not conduct garbage collection and recycling operations on the following holidays:

Holiday

Alternate Collection Day

Independence Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day

Thursday, July 5th
Friday, November 23rd
Wednesday, December 26th

If your regular collection day falls on one of the holidays, it will be collected on the alternate day as noted above.

SYRINGE DISPOSAL:

Syringes MUST NOT be placed in household garbage for collection. Syringes may be taken to the security officer's desk located at WCA Hospital's Emergency Entrance, Monday - Saturday, 7:00 am - 3:00 pm for proper disposal. Syringes for disposal must be placed in a closed clear plastic container such as a plastic soda bottle.

NOTE: Certain items are no longer accepted at the Chautauqua County Landfill for disposal. See the enclosed memorandum for details.
